

RULES

As our guests, please observe these rules, and most importantly, let us be reminded of the Golden Rule

"Do unto others as you would have them do unto you."

- *Please respect the property of neighbors to the east and west of the park and do not trespass. Respect neighbors in the park by not cutting through sites.*
- *Beach Access: is between site 811 and 812 and west of site 800 on the beachfront row.*
- ***Campers:** CHECK-IN time is Noon, CHECKOUT time is 11:00am. **Cabins:** CHECK-IN time is 4pm, CHECKOUT time is 11:00am.*
- *Parents are fully responsible for the behavior and safety of their children. All children under the age of 16 must wear a helmet when riding bicycles, scooters & skateboards. NO bicycles, scooters or skateboards to be ridden in the park after dark.*
- *The pool tables/bumper pool, are for guests 16 and up. Children must be under the **direct** supervision of a parent/adult guardian.*
- *Swim at your own risk. No glass containers allowed on beach or in pool areas. No alcohol allowed on pool decks. Use caution and watch for undertow. Stay out of deep waters. Abide by the Beach Warning Flags.*
- *The South pool is open from 9 AM - Dusk. The North pool is open from 9AM - 9 PM. There is no lifeguard on duty. An adult must accompany all children 16 and under. Swim at your own risk.*
- *The speed limit for the park is 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ MPH and will be **STRICTLY ENFORCED** for the safety of everyone.*
- *Please park your RV and car / truck in your designated site only and display your parking pass at all times.*
- *Please do not drive on the beach or sandy areas. Car owners are responsible for towing expenses.*
- *Please do not give the security code to anyone. Have your visitors register, get a car pass and a copy of the rules.*
- *All guests and visitors must register at the office - a car pass will be issued to all vehicles.*
- *All visitors are subject to a "Day Use" fee of \$5.00 per day.*
- *Quiet time is 10:00 PM. Excessive noise, nuisance, public drunkenness, nudity, and fireworks are not permitted.*
- *Pets are allowed at all sites EXCEPT Beachfront. Local law prohibits pets on the beach. Pets must be controlled at all times and kept on a leash. Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets. Please look for our three Dogipot stations located on the south side of the store, south side of the pool, and by the dumpster at the beach bath house. Pet owners are fully responsible for the behavior and safety of their pets. Pets are not permitted in any building in the park, the patio or pool decks.*
- *Florida Health Department prohibits the dumping gray water on the ground. A dump station is located next to the northern uppermost bathhouse. Pump-outs are available daily for Beach Front sites (sign up before 8:30 a.m.) at a cost of \$10.00 (plus tax). CAMPING on the GULF requires a mandatory use of holding tank treatment chemicals in order to receive our pump-out services.*
- *Sewer doughnuts are required by Florida State Law. If you do not have one, you may purchase one at our store.*
- *Use of water at campsites for non-potable services, such as washing of vehicles, is prohibited by state water authorities. Please use the pressure washer located behind the store.*
- *Campers are responsible for keeping their sites clean. Please do not throw cigarette butts or other trash on the ground.*
- *Smoking is not permitted inside any building in the park.*
- *Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in either pool areas or on the activity center deck. At all other times, alcohol beverages must be discreetly packaged in a cup or coozie.*
- *Please use garbage dumpsters. Please do not place food in bathhouse trash cans or wash dishes in the bathhouse sinks.*
- *Clotheslines are permitted behind your unit only. Please do not use trees to hang clotheslines or hammocks.*
- *Campers are solely responsible for any injury or accidents they are involved in. Neither Camping on the Gulf nor their employees are responsible for any damages incurred to your property during your stay.*
- *Fires at your campsite are only permitted with the use of pre-approved above ground fire pits.*
- *Fires are not permitted on the beach.*
- *Beach cabanas, lounge chairs and umbrellas must be removed from the beach at the end of the day, per Beach Activities Ordinance 2003-07 Section 10D6.*
- *Sleeping tents are allowed only in the "Upper Park." Sleeping in Non-Camping vehicles is not permitted without a tent.*
