

Directions to CAMPING on the GULF

FROM PENSACOLA (West of here, traveling East):

Take Highway 98 East through Destin. We are approximately 10 miles from the Destin bridge. When you go out of town you will pass a Wal-Mart on the left, then you will pass a traffic light at Highway 293 (Mid Bay Bridge), continue on Highway 98 East for 5 miles. At about $4\frac{3}{4}$ miles the road will bend to the left and turn into a six lane road. We are on the right, watch for our large 70' American flag, large "Enter" sign and large "CAMPING on the GULF" sign.

FROM MISSISSIPPI OR LOUISIANA (I-10 East):

Take I-10 East past Pensacola. Exit at Crestview onto Highway 85 South. Go south on Highway 85 to Highway 20. Go left on Highway 20, turn right on Highway 293 South (Mid Bay Bridge). There is a \$2.50 toll for automobiles and an additional \$2.50 per axle for RVs. Go over the bridge to the light at Highway 98. Turn left onto Highway 98 go 5 miles. At about $4\frac{3}{4}$ miles the road will bend to the left and turn into a six lane road. We are on the right, watch for our large 70' American flag, large "Enter" sign and large "CAMPING on the GULF" sign.

FROM PANAMA CITY (East of here, traveling West):

Take Highway 98 WEST toward Destin. We are 38 miles from the west side of Panama City. You will pass the junction for Highway 331 on the right 9 miles before the park. Continue on Highway 98. The road will change from two lanes to six lanes with a center turning lane a little over a mile from the park. We are $\frac{3}{4}$ miles past the water tower on the left. Watch for our large 70' American Flag, large "Enter" sign and large "CAMPING on the GULF" sign.

FROM DOTHAN, ALABAMA (Coming down Highway 231):

Follow 231 SOUTH to I-10. Go WEST on I-10 to EXIT 85 which is Highway 331. Make a LEFT and go SOUTH on Highway 331 through Freeport. Go approximately 8 miles over the 331 bridge and to the end of 331. Make a RIGHT on Highway 98, you are now 9 miles from the park. The road will change from two lanes to six lanes with a center turning lane a little over a mile from the park. We are $\frac{3}{4}$ miles past the water tower on the LEFT. Watch for our large 70' American Flag, large "Enter" sign and large "CAMPING on the GULF" sign.
